PURPOSE:

The American Rescue Plan Act Application will help to equitably distribute funding to community-based organizations, nonprofits, businesses, and Town of Old Saybrook Government Services (departments/boards/commissions) for eligible reimbursements, programs, services and capital investments that address the negative impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency and create new, transformative opportunities for Old Saybrook residents. Program funds are not intended to replace other federal, state, or local town assistance programs; applicants may not receive program funding for project expenses that were funded through other federal, state, or local grants/programs.

BACKGROUND:

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) will provide more than \$2.9 million in State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLRF) to the Town of Old Saybrook (Town) to assist in the recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic. SLFRF payments are intended to be prospective and used to address an economic need that has arisen from the pandemic. All funds must be obligated by the Town of Old Saybrook by December 31, 2024, and all funds must be spent by grantees no later than December 31, 2026.

The Town can only use SLRF to:

- Provide for government services up to the amount of SLRF received by the Town of Old Saybrook,
- Respond to public health and negative economic impacts as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic,
- Provide premium pay to workers performing essential work, and
- Invest in Water/Sewer/Broadband infrastructure.
